11 - 1 Home of Larry Kent - collection includes life size paper mache works by the Linares family and Frida Kahlo memorabilia, Pre-Columbian and Inuit art, Haitian, Mexican, and Andean artifacts and furniture

1:30- 3 Home of Ed and Mina Smith, passionate collectors of African, Oceanic, and the Americas as represented by statuary, masks, ceramics, beadwork and textiles. Many pieces are on loan to the DeYoung Museum, college galleries, and the Sana Foundation.

Dessert and Treats

3:30-5 Home of Jake and Todd Figi with a unique Latin collection of 150 paintings, drawings, woodcuts, sketches, and sculptures of the Modern Masters from Mexico, Cuba, Columbia and other Latin countries - Tamayo, Rivera, Kahlo, Siqueiros, Orozco et al and the Chilean surrealist, Roberto Matta (30 pieces). Works by Henry Moore, Calder, Dali, Rembrandt, Gaudi sit alongside objects from the Tang Dynasty, Angkor Wat and Korea. 100 crosses from the 17th C to the present made from ivory to beer bottle caps also stand out in the Figi collection.
